

SUGGESTED FABRICS

Kilti Medium-weight woested twill tartan wool (about 15 oz. is ideal for the man's Kilt, 11 oz. for the woman's Kilt Skirt). Jacket and Vests Suit-quality medium-weight wool or blend. Jacket lapels should be silk peau de soie or similar quality. Kilt Lining: Finely woven sturdy cotton. Jacket and Vest Lining: Medium-weight lining fabric.

NOTIONS

Kiltr Thread; 1 yd/.95m hair canvas or heavy linen interfacing, two 5½*/14cm by 1½*/29mm leather belt tabs; two corresponding backles.

Kilt Skirt: Thread, waistband interfacing (1/2 times waist size plus seam allowances); one 5½/1-icm by 1½/29mm leather belt tab and corresponding buckle; one ½/19mm button or Velcro* closure for inside waistband.

Jackets Thread; 1 yd/.95m woven or weft-insertion fusible suiting interfacing; 1½ yds/1.58m ¾/9.5mm wide stay tape; 1 pair standard ½/13mm thick shoulder pads (nor precovered); twenty ¾/19mm square metal buttons. Vests Thread; ¼ yd/.96m woven or weft-insertion fusible

Vest: Thread; ¾ yd./09cm woven or welt-insertion fusible suiting interfacing; three ¾*/16mm square metal buttons; one standard vest belt buckle.
